

Illinois Budgeting for Results Commission Meeting Minutes for May 30, 2025

Welcome and Introductions

Commissioner Clemons-Mosby called the meeting to order at 1:30 pm. Attendees gathered at the following locations:

Review and Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes

Commissioner Maruna moved to approve the BFR Commission meeting minutes of April 25, 2025. Commissioner Duncan seconded the motion. The motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

Briefing on Illinois Film Industry

Peter Hawley, Deputy Director of the Illinois Film Office at the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity provided a briefing on Illinois' film industry. The commissioners held brief discussion after the presentation.

Votes on Topic for Public Hearing and its Virtual Status

Commissioner Clemons-Mosby discussed the annual BFR Public Hearing for 2025 and commissioners provided suggestions of topics for the annual hearing. After discussion, Commissioner Clemons-Mosby outlined the briefing on Illinois' Five-Year Economic Growth Plan and the impact of state programming on vulnerable and disadvantaged populations. Commissioner Gonzalez moved to approve the 2025 annual BFR Public Hearing topic. Commissioner Duncan seconded the motion. The motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

Commissioner Duncan moved that the annual BFR Public Hearing take place physically in Chicago and Springfield and to include virtual participation by presenters and the public. Commissioner Rivait seconded the motion. The motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

Update on Benefit-Cost Analysis

Adam Groner, GOMB Economist, provided a briefing on the BFR Unit's program assessment activities, including new resources and avenues for further development of the Unit's program assessments and the benefit-cost model moving forward. The commissioners held brief discussion after the presentation.

Update on the Interactive Dashboard and IPRS

Curt Clemons-Mosby, BFR Staff director, provided a briefing on the updates to the Interactive Budget Dashboard, including the integration of the Interactive Budget Dashboard with the performance data of the IPRS system. The commissioners held brief discussion after the presentation.

Ethics Training and Appointments Reminder
