The Commission wants to promote stakeholder awareness of and utilization of its Fiscal Scan. During calendar year 2025, the Commission will develop and begin implementing outreach activities to promote the scan. The commission will also explore developing user-friendly tools and resources to support people in utilizing the Fiscal Scan to and heightening awareness of how the state invests in youth.	3a	Included
The YBC Commission intends to compare budgets for adolescent programming and services in Illinois to other states. During calendar year 2025, a commission meeting should include discussion with relevant stakeholders to better understand how other states and jurisdictions are benchmarking adolescent funding and/or the outcomes of adolescent programs and services. If the Commission recommends specific benchmarks be used for Illinois, future fiscal scans would include those national and/or peer state benchmarking metrics.	4a	Included
